Turkey In Crisis: Guilty Until Proven Innocent

The end of January is quickly approaching and this year, 2018, has already proven to be the worst year for universal human rights in the Republic of Turkey. According to the Freedom House's annual report, Turkey is no longer a free country. Press and net freedom are non-existent.

Turkey is no longer a country where rule-of-law reigns. The Erdogan regime extended the emergency rule, declared in the aftermath of July 15 2016, by 3 more months. An emergency decree, no. 675, published in the Official Gazette legalized vigilantism.

Similarly, women and children rights are systematically ignored. More than 668 babies are in the prison system. Authorities plan to build 174 new prisons within the next five years in order to create space for hundreds of thousands of civilians, men, women, and children, falsely charged with orchestrating a coup.
