



Human Rights Violations in Turkey by Numbers: Non-Gov't Organizations

- The government suspended by decree the activities of **370** nongovernmental associations (November 2016)[1]
- Hundreds of Turkey's leading women's and children's human rights NGOs and foundations are among **1,125** (one thousand one hundred twenty-five) registered associations/NGO, **560** (five hundred sixty) foundations and **19** (nineteen) trade unions permanently closed through a series of government decrees since the July 15, 2016 attempted coup.[2]
