REPORTS

Each year we produce more than 15 reports about the violations of human rights in Turkey.



AST PAPERS

Every year approximately 12 papers about human rights concerns in Turkey are created by AST.



APH PROJECT

Archiving Persecution of Hizmet project records up to 80 victims' stories per year.



INFOGRAPHICS AND DOCUMENTARIES

AST creates around 12 infographics, and 15 videos and documentaries per year.









CAMPAIGNS AND EVENTS

AST urges everyone to take action by calling and sending letters and video messages to international, governmental, and non-governmental organizations to raise awareness about all human rights violations happening in Turkey. This includes but is not limited to the abductions and illegal extraditions, torture and suspicious deaths in Turkish prisons, people dying while fleeing from Erdogan's Regime in the sea.

Tortures and mistreatments in Turkish prisons. Confiscations, threats and hate speech used against the critics of the government.

Lastly, we urge everyone to take action to stop the social genocide of the opponents and to free thousands of political prisoners in Turkey.

CHAMPIONING HUMAN RIGHTS

AST holds conventions to bring light to the ongoing conflict and its influences in Turkey. Also to develop strategies to champion human rights worldwide through panels, discussions, workshops, art and photo exhibitions, and legal training sessions. Some examples of these are The Freedom Forum, Immigrant Women Empowerment Panel, film festivals, and movie screenings. Also AST members attend conferences held by other human rights organizations.
