




For those who have life-changing events continue to happen without family and are separated from those they love because they cannot risk traveling to a place where they could be arrested and put into prison.




Representation of the large numbers of professionals forced to leave Turkey to find freedom, those who were dismissed from academic positions, or arrested and put into prison.












Children are told they are camping to distract them from the reality of living in an internment camp after escaping Turkey.





